1. Mitigation Plan; Grant Application Update
 - a. Frank Maynard and Gary Baker with FRC Emergency Management were present to discuss the 2025 revision of the FRC Pre Disaster Mitigation Plan. Their office will be managing the effort and grant activities for the update in conjunction with Black Hills Council of Governments. The effort requires representatives from each community, jurisdiction and major facility to participate in the plan update. Meetings will likely start around July 2024.
2. The Committee discussed the need for Crosswalk markings at various locations, many of which were brought up during the Business Owner's meeting with the SD-DOT. These locations have been forwarded to the Street Department for action.
